Applicant Qualifications:

1. Must apply in person with photocopies of **all** required documents listed below.
2. Must be 18 years of age by September 1, 2024
3. Must have a High School Diploma or equivalent or are currently a High School Senior and shall earn a high school diploma or equivalent by July 1, 2024
4. Provide a doctor's letter stating you are physically capable of performing work of this trade (Please refer to handout, *Duties of an Apprentice*). This is not a physical, just a letter.
5. Be able to successfully complete an aptitude test administered at our Training Center by the Committee or other competent organization.
6. Be a citizen of the United States
7. \$50 Non-Refundable Application Fee (money order/bank check only) Please make payable to LU 537 ETF. **Cash is not accepted. Waived for veterans.**

Required Documents: *photocopies* of the following documents **must** be submitted with application.

1. *High School Diploma or GED *unless you are a HS Senior (seniors should submit transcript)
2. Transcript of High School Grades – you may use a final transcript w/ graduation date in place of diploma
3. Birth Certificate
4. Social Security Card
5. Valid Driver's License
6. Letter from a doctor stating the applicant can work without any restrictions. Do not submit physical..
7. Form DD-214 Military Discharge (**if applicable**)
8. Prior year's W-2 Form (**if applicable**)
9. Copy of Driving Record from RMV – **for HVAC applicants only.**

Applicants will be notified of their aptitude test date and time at the time of application.
